"We're just a normal family that has a successful business and we were willing to take this step." The step was the establishment of The Giving Tree Fund, a donor-advised fund at the Hartford Foundation, which in years to come will award grants in support of nonprofits in Greater Hartford.

"We are very fortunate. Our family has a good life. We think it's our duty to give back to the community," says Stacey. "We want our children to understand that there are people who have needs. They are going to have a real understanding of what philanthropy is all about."

Last year, the Hartford Foundation awarded grants totaling almost \$29 million to help improve the quality of life for residents of the region.
