Infoshred participates in Shred Fest 2013 with Fairfield County Medical Association to raise funds for AmeriCares

Many folks came out on September 28th to the FCMA headquarters in Shelton with their confidential material. Infoshred donated a mobile shredding unit and stationed it at the event to receive the material intended for shredding from members. Folks paid \$5 a bag or box to have their material shredded. All the funds raised went to support AmeriCares free clinics. AmeriCares Free Clinics mission is to provide high-quality health care to Connecticut's low-income, uninsured residents while protecting each patient's sense of dignity and self-respect. For every \$1 donated AmeriCares can provide \$4 of medical care.
